
X-9. VANCOUVER PATTERN—by HARTH, Winter MW

This pattern of darts and kites consists of a thick-bordered ring (three words, proceeding clockwise), and 26 five-tile figures ("stars" and "suns"). Each contains a five-letter word, with half running clockwise, and half counterclockwise. In addition, 13 nine-letter words, in order, form a single winding path in the diagram, going from tile to neighboring tile by crossing edges, and never passing through a tile more than once. The path leaves one letter unchecked in every Fives or Ring entry, except in the Five where it ends, which is fully checked. All Nines are "Vancouver pattern" words: the first and seventh letter are the same, and all other letters are different. For each, either the first or the seventh letter is ignored in the wordplay. All entries start in the correspondingly labeled tile.
